



HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

The Titus 2 model of older women living out the gospel and training younger women to do the same is vital. It's how we all thrive, how we are adorned with the beauty of Christ, and how we live out the gospel . . . together.

This small group study guide has been designed to help you cultivate a Titus 2 lifestyle in company with other women. These intentional, grace-infused relationships are indispensable if we want to experience the growth, community, and influence God designed us to have in the church and the world.

Ideally, invite a mix of older and younger women to participate in this study. This is a great way to start cross-generational conversations and develop meaningful, fruitful relationships between women who might not otherwise connect with each other.

Here are some suggestions for using this guide with a friend or a group of women.

Before your group meets:

- Read the week's chapter in *Adorned: Living Out the Beauty of the Gospel Together* (available for purchase at AdornedBook.com).
- Journal your response to questions in this study guide and/or the "Making It Personal" questions found at the end of the chapter in *Adorned*.

When your group meets:

- Watch the corresponding DVD message.
- Discuss the questions and talking points in this guide and/or the "Making It Personal" questions in *Adorned*. Don't worry about getting through all the questions. Select the ones that generate the most interest and dialogue.
