ACCESSING THE STREAM DURING THE WEEKEND:

- Be sure to enter your email address to access the stream (even if you've preregistered).

"I was from a good, Bible-believing church in Kenya, but when I got married, I followed my husband into his church. I immediately felt uncomfortable. There was doctrinal heresy, sins that were not dealt with, spiritual deadness, no cohesion among believers, and prosperity gospel oriented sermons.

"I started to nag and complain to my husband at every opportunity I could, pleading, begging—even demanding—we leave the church. This did not work. My husband saw the problems with the church, but felt it difficult to leave, as he had attended there since relocating to our town years before.

"I was so frustrated. I began to hate Sundays. I started to despise giving to God because of coercion and manipulation I felt at church.

"Several months later, my husband told me to set a date to visit our pastor so we could tell him we were leaving. Praise the Lord! We have since found another church which I love. God is truly amazing.

Seeking Him Through his word

Use these pages as a guide to turn your heart toward God's Word each day of the conference. Find a quiet corner or gather together with a small group of friends and reflect on key passages using the questions below.



BREAKING GROUND Hosea 10:12-13

The theme verse for this conference is found in the Old Testament book of Hosea, a collection of poems that show God's desire to restore His wayward people. Write out Hosea 10:12 here:

"For it is the time to _____."

When Hosea wrote this, God's people were in a sad state of spiritual and moral decline. They had turned away from God and replaced Him with other things. Look up these verses and match them to the act of unfaithfulness they highlight:

- God's people worshipped false gods. •
- God's people knew about God intellectually but didn't know God relationally.
- God's people trusted in political alliances with other nations rather than trusting God.
- Hosea 5:13; 7:11
- Hosea 4:1; 6:6
- Hosea 2:8, 13, 16–17

Can you relate to any of this? How have you been unfaithful to God as of late?

Hosea delivered repeated rebukes and appeals to God's people. If they would not return to the Lord, he warned, judgment would surely come. Write out the essence of Hosea's charge against the Israelites in your own words (Hos. 10:12–13).

Do you feel God is being too harsh on His people? Explain your answer.

God had every right to end His covenant with His people because they had been unfaithful to Him. They would still experience severe consequences for their sin, but rather than divorcing them, God would renew His covenant with them. Why? *Because His love was greater than their sin.*

You are probably familiar with the story of Hosea and Gomer in Hosea 1–3. Why did God tell Hosea to marry Gomer (3:1)?

What even greater "object lesson" do we have today that highlights God's covenant faithfulness and steadfast love for us (Luke 22:20)?

Perhaps your own heart is hungering for intimacy with God—an intimacy that you haven't enjoyed for a long time and do not feel you deserve. That very desire is God-initiated. He wants you back! Why? Because He loves you and knows that you cannot experience all He has for you in your present condition. It is time for you to seek the Lord. He is waiting for you! How can you practically seek Him today?

Write a prayer of gratitude to God for His faithful love for you and for the great lengths He went to in sending His Son to earth to restore you when you had wandered away from Him.

Reflections





The need for believers to return wholeheartedly to God—to be revived—is addressed in Revelation 2:1–7.

This passage of Scripture is a letter to the church of Ephesus, and it's written in the first-person. Who is speaking in Revelation 2:1–7 (see Rev. 1:9–2:1)?

The church at Ephesus had once been a vibrant group of believers. What does Jesus commend these believers for (Rev. 2:2–3)? Circle all that apply:

- They were committed to sound doctrine.
- They were known for their faith in Him.
- They had persevered for His sake.
- They were all about service.
- They were known for their love for God and for others.

After commending their strengths, Jesus addresses a matter of grave concern to Him. What had the church at Ephesus done that displeased Him (v. 4)?

Jesus is issuing the cry of a wounded lover. We've heard strains of this same chorus before in passages like Jeremiah 2 and Hosea 4.

Over the years, the Christians at Ephesus had somehow lost sight of Jesus. Their love for Him had lost its fervor. They had transferred their affection elsewhere, which would cost them dearly if something didn't change.

We see God's gracious heart in pointing this out. Revival never begins when a struggling, wayward person decides to return to the Lord. Rather, revival begins when our loving heavenly Father—wanting us to enjoy the safety and security of His love—calls us back to Himself. God is the initiator; the call to revival is a plea of love from the heart of God.
How about you? Can you identify any rivals that could be competing with your initial love for God?

How would you describe your current relationship with Jesus? Where is your heart in relation to loving Him?

In spite of His concern, Jesus doesn't leave these believers without hope; He gives them the prescription to regain what they've lost. What instructions does Jesus give to those who have left their first love (Rev. 2:5)?

In light of this counsel, what steps can you take to restore your love for Christ?

In Revelation 2:5, Jesus includes a stern warning to those who neglect their love relationship with Him. What might it look like for a church to have its "lampstand removed"? (Perhaps you've seen a church with plenty of people filling the pews and lots of programs on their weekly calendar—but the "light" of God's glory has departed.)

Jesus then ends with a gracious promise to those who "overcome" or "conquer." What promise is given to "the one who conquers" (Rev. 2:7)?

This promise is a reversal of the consequences of sin in the garden of Eden! Read Genesis 3:22–24.

What "tree" opened the way for us to partake of the tree of life? (See 1 Peter 2:24.) Spend some time thanking Him for that now.

"I spent my teen years as a self-righteous rule-follower. I preached at people at school and at my sisters, but I was such a hypocrite. Behind closed doors, I never read the Bible and struggled to 'follow the rules' myself.

"By the time I was eighteen, I gave up, because I realized I would never be good enough. I started drinking and having sex with my boyfriend. I got pregnant, so my boyfriend and I married immediately.

"Within a year, I was staying home with our baby and resentful of my husband. I decided a degree and a good job would fix my problems. After finishing school, my husband and I were on the brink of getting a divorce, and I almost started giving my heart to another man. I hated working, I hated being at home, and I struggled with anger and depression.

"One day, I begged God to give me a friend. Just one friend! That week I met a woman who invited us to church, and she became my first God-fearing friend. Soon after, I met another woman who told me about *Revive Our Hearts*. Everything started instantly changing when I began listening: My personal walk with Christ. My womanhood. My marriage. My mothering.

"I began to forgive, and I asked forgiveness from many. I began to respect my husband and longed to be home with my son. I started parenting out of grace rather than fear. I actually *wanted* to read the Bible and have community with other believers.

"As I changed, my husband accepted Christ and was baptized! My sisters, dad, and stepdad always talk about how different I am, and my relationship is so much better with them.

"Now I don't need to 'measure up' because Christ took all my sin and shame on Himself; He loves me. God loves me! That's all I need. I don't look for my joy and fulfillment in people anymore. Only God. He is the only One who will ever give me true peace, joy, and fulfillment."

PREPARING MY HEART *for Revival*

DO YOU NEED REVIVAL?

Maybe you know for sure that your heart needs to be revived. It's why you're participating in this conference, but you don't know where to begin. This inventory will help you pinpoint a personal starting point.

Maybe you're walking well with the Lord, and you're not sure you need revival. This inventory will allow God's Spirit to open the eyes of your heart to anything you might be missing. Take some time here and there throughout this weekend, and even into the beginning of next week, to prayerfully walk through these reflection questions and Scriptures.

1. Genuine salvation (2 Cor. 5:17)

- a. Was there a time in my life when I genuinely repented of (was aware of and turned away from) my sin?
- b. Was there a time when I placed all my trust in Jesus Christ alone to save me?
- c. Was there ever a time when I completely surrendered to Jesus Christ as the Master and Lord of my life?

2. God's Word (Ps. 119:97, 140)

- a. Do I have a desire to read and meditate on the Word of God?
- b. Is my personal devotional life consistent and meaningful?
- c. Do I seek to apply God's Word to my everyday life?

3. Humility (Isa. 57:15)

- a. Am I quick to recognize and agree with God in confession when I have sinned?
- b. Am I quick to admit to others when I am wrong?
- c. Do I count others and their interests to be more significant than myself and my interests?

4. Obedience (1 Sam. 15:22; Heb. 13:17)

- a. Am I quick to obey when God shows me something in His Word that pleases (or displeases) Him?
- b. Do I obey the human authorities God has placed over my life?



5. Pure heart (1 John 1:9)

- a. Do I keep short sin accounts with God by confessing and forsaking all known sin as He convicts?
- b. Am I willing to give up all sin for God?
- c. Do I love and dwell on things that are true, pure, and good?

6. Clear conscience (Acts 24:16)

- a. Do I seek forgiveness from those I wrong or offend?
- b. Is my conscience clear with every person? (Can I honestly say, "There is no one I have ever wronged or offended in any way and not gone back to that person and sought his forgiveness and made it right"?)

7. Priorities (Matt. 6:33)

- a. Does my schedule reveal that God is first in my life?
- b. Do my spending habits reveal that God is first in my life?

8. Values (Col. 3:2)

- a. Do I love what God loves and hate what God hates?
- b. Do I value the things that please God (for example: studying His Word, praying, giving, sharing the gospel with others, acts of mercy)?
- c. Are my affections and goals fixed on eternal values?

9. Sacrifice (Phil. 3:7-8)

- a. Am I willing to sacrifice whatever is necessary to see God move in my life and church (time, convenience, comfort, reputation, pleasure, habits, and so on)?
- b. Is my life characterized by generosity and sacrifice for the sake of Jesus and others?

10. Spirit control (Gal. 5:22-25; Eph. 5:18-21)

- a. Am I allowing Jesus to be Lord of every area of my life?
- b. Am I allowing the Holy Spirit to fill (control) my life each day?
- c. Is there growing evidence of the fruit of the Spirit being produced in my life?

11. "First love" (Phil. 1:21, 23)

- a. Am I as devoted to Jesus as I have been in the past?
- b. Am I attentive to Jesus, filled with His joy and peace, and making Him theobject of my affection?

12. Motives (Matt. 10:28; Acts 5:29)

- a. Am I more concerned about what God thinks about my life than about what others think?
- b. Would I pray, read my Bible, give, and serve as much if nobody but God ever noticed?
- c. Am I more concerned about pleasing God than I am about being accepted by and appreciated by others?

13. Moral purity (Eph. 5:3-4)

- a. Do I keep my mind free from entertainment or input that could stimulate fantasy or thoughts that are not morally pure?
- b. Are my conversations and behavior pure and in accordance with God's Word?
- 14. Forgiveness (Col. 3:12-13)
 - a. Do I seek to resolve relational conflicts as soon as possible?
 - b. Am I quick to bear with and forgive those who wrong or hurt me?
- 15. Evangelism (Luke 24:47-48; Rom. 9:3)
 - a. Do I have a burden for those who do not know or follow Jesus?
 - b. Am I alert to opportunities to share the gospel with non-believers?

16. Prayer (1 Tim. 2:1)

- a. Am I faithful in praying for the needs of others?
- b. Do I pray for true revival in my life, my church, my nation, and our world?

17. Genuine love (1 Cor. 13:1-8)

- a. Do I exhibit the characteristics of true love in my relationships with others?
- b. Do I seek the good of others above my own interests?
- c. Do I treat all others as valuable image-bearers of God?

18. Compassion and kindness (1 Cor. 13:1-8)

- a. Do I demonstrate a heart for those who are needy, vulnerable, or disenfranchised?
- b. Do I reach out to practically meet those needs, even if it is costly or those in need are in a different demographic or socio-economic status than me?

The Preparing My Heart For Revival inventory is taken from *Seeking Him: Experiencing the Joy of Personal Revival.* This classic study by Nancy DeMoss Wolgemuth and Tim Grissom has been refreshed and is available in the Resource Center.
