



### *Tenet 1: Revival*

What happens when God's people, whether individually or corporately, are restored to a right relationship with Him.

EZRA 10:1–12; HOSEA 10:12; JEREMIAH 3:19–4:4



### *Tenet 2: Humility*

Recognizing oneself as a sinner before the holy God.

LUKE 14:11; MICAH 6:6–8; LUKE 19:9–14



### *Tenet 3: Honesty*

A willingness to be honest with God and others about our true spiritual condition.

PSALM 32:1–5; PROVERBS 28:13; ACTS 5:1–11



### *Tenet 4: Repentance*

Returning to the Lord, forsaking sin, and obeying God.

PSALM 51:10; EZEKIEL 18:30–32; LUKE 15:1–7; ACTS 3:17–20



### *Tenet 5: Grace*

The free gift of God, which He gives to those who have sinned against Him and deserve only His wrath, to meet His requirements and to face the difficulties of life.

JOHN 1:14–18; ROMANS 5:12–17; TITUS 2:11–14; HEBREWS 4:16



### *Tenet 6: Holiness*

The outworking and fruit of God separating us from sin and setting us apart for Himself.

PSALM 99; EPHESIANS 1:3–4; 5:25–27; HEBREWS 12:14



### *Tenet 7: Obedience*

Building your life on hearing and doing the will of God.

DEUTERONOMY 30:11–20; JOHN 14:15; 1 JOHN 2:3–6; 5:1–5



### *Tenet 8: Clear Conscience*

To have no unconfessed sin between you and God or any other person.

ACTS 24:16; HEBREWS 9:11–14; 1 PETER 3:13–17; 1 JOHN 3:19–24



### *Tenet 9: Forgiveness*

A commitment to clear the other person's record and never to hold that offense against him again.

LUKE 17:1–4; 23:32–43; EPHESIANS 4:29–5:2



### *Tenet 10: Sexual Purity*

Determining to be morally blameless in all our thoughts, activities, and relationships.

PSALM 119:1–16; PROVERBS 5; 1 CORINTHIANS 6:12–20; 1 THESSALONIANS 4:1–8



### *Tenet 11: The Spirit-Filled Life*

Confessing any and all known sin, walking in moment-by-moment obedience to His leadership, and relying on Him to live His life through us.

PSALM 139:7–12; JOHN 14:15–17; 2 CORINTHIANS 5:1–5; GALATIANS 5:16



### *Tenet 12: The Personal Devotional Life*

The practice of spending time alone each day with God in His Word and in prayer.

PSALM 27:4; 63:1–8; MATTHEW 6:5–15; 2 TIMOTHY 3:14–4:5
