

Seeking the Lord for Revival

Prayer Guide

Ten years ago, before God called me to become the women's ministry director at my church, He impressed on my heart that I was to serve my church by praying for revival. I haven't stopped since then. I'm praying for our entire church family and most specifically for the women I serve and for those I serve alongside.

I believe what Andrew Murray said is true, "The coming revival must begin with a great revival of prayer."

Fellow leader, I hope you'll join me in seeking God for what He already wants to do: Revive His beloved Church.



- 1. Pray declarations of God's unsearchable greatness, and give thanks that He brought everything together through Christ, for His glory (Psalm 145; Eph. 1:3–12).
- 2. Submit yourself and pray that others would submit to the sovereignty of the Father (Deut. 4:35; Psalm 131).
- 3. Humble yourself before the Lord (Psalm 25:9; Phil. 2:5-8).
- 4. Declare trust and willingness to both follow God and to be used by Him in whatever way He chooses (Psalm 9:10; Matt. 16:24).
- 5. Ask the Lord to demolish strongholds in yourself and others (Psalm 119:13; 2 Cor. 10:5).
- 6. Ask the Lord to prepare minds to recognize sin and to make hearts willing to repent of that sin, including yours (Hos. 10:12; 1 Pet. 1:13).

7. Seek the Lord.

- Seek Him with all your heart and all your soul (Deut. 4:29; Psalm 105:3-4).
- Seek His face and acknowledge your full dependence on His strength (1 Chron. 16:11).
- Seek Him so that you will not wander from His commands (Psalm 119:10).
- Set your face, just as Christ set His, towards the Father's will and glory (Luke 9:51).
- 8. Declare your hope that God has heard and will answer (Isa. 55:6-7).

Pray these things by yourself and with other women. Ask the Lord to use your prayers and His Word to fuel you. (Isa. 61:1–3; 2 Tim. 3:16–17). Then listen and respond (1 John 1:1–4; 3:12–14; Heb. 11:6).

As we pray these things for our churches and ministries, may His entire Kingdom be strengthened and expanded—all for His glory!
