Quick Connect

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Genesis 1:31a God saw all that he had made and it was very good indeed.

Revelation 4:11 Our Lord and God, you are worthy to receive glory and honor and power because you have created all things, and by your will they exist and were created.

Discuss: Who created everything? What did God say about everything He created? Look closely at something He made? What can you learn about Him as you look? Tell God what you love about something He made.

Go Deeper

Passages to Read: Genesis chapter 1 through 2:3 As you read these verses, look for the verbs. You'll learn more about God and how He created everything!

Questions to Talk About

- What were some of the verbs you heard in the creation account? Did you learn anything new about God?
- What are some ways we are made in God's image? (We can think, reason, imagine, love, and know what is good.)
