Quick Connect

Genesis 6:5-6 When the Lord saw that human wickedness was widespread on the earth and that every inclination of the human mind was nothing but evil all the time, the Lord regretted that he had made man on the earth, and he was deeply grieved.

Genesis 7:1 and 11-12 Then the Lord said to Noah, "Enter the ark, you and all your household, for I have seen that you alone are righteous before me in this generation. In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, on the seventeenth day of the month, on that day all the sources of the vast watery depths burst open, the floodgates of the sky were opened, and the rain fell on the earth forty days and forty nights.

Genesis 9:13 I have placed my bow in the clouds, and it will be a sign of the covenant between me and the earth.

Discuss: What kind of thoughts did every person have? How did God feel about this? Only Noah was righteous. How did God save him and his family? God promised He would never again send a worldwide flood. What sign did He give us to show that He would keep this promise?

Questions to Talk About

- What kind of thoughts did every person have? How did God feel about this?
- Who was the only person who did what was right? What did God tell Noah to do?
- Besides rain falling from the sky, where did more water come from? (Gen. 7:11)
- What did God promise Noah, his family, and all of us? (9:15) Has He kept His promise about never flooding the whole earth again?

Make it Personal

God rescued Noah's family. We need to be rescued, too, because we sin. The Bible says the punishment for sin is death. John 3:16 says, "God loved the world in this way: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish, but have eternal life." We can believe Jesus took the punishment we deserve for our sins. Have you asked Him to forgive you? Do you believe He died for you?
