Review

Reflect

Moses exhorts Joshua to “be strong and courageous” (Deut. 31:6, 7, 23). How does his encouragement speak to you today?

Respond

Write a short prayer, based on today’s reading. This could include praise, gratitude, personal confession, agreement with the truth, or a request for yourself or someone else.
